



## Student Discount Card | Student Discount & Parking Card

### *Terms and Conditions - Updated in March 2022*

***Use of the Market City Student Discount Cards is always governed by these terms and conditions.***

- In order to be eligible for a Student Discount Card or Student Discount & Parking Card, you must be a full or part time NSW student with a valid student card and student number.
- The student parking card promotion is conducted by Market City in conjunction with Wilson Parking, 2 Quay Street, Haymarket, Sydney, 2000.
- We have two student card options available:
  1. **Student Discount Card** - packed with exclusive Market City discounts.
    - To pick up option 1, please go to the Level 1 **Information Desk** from Wednesday to Sunday, 10:00am to 5:00pm.
  2. **Student Discount and Parking Card** - for Market City discounts and exclusive \$16 parking rate
    - To pick up option 2, please go to the **B1 Parking Office** from Monday to Friday, 10:00am to 5:00pm (excluding public holidays). You are required to do an immediate \$50 credit top-up on this card. Your first day of parking is free and from then on, you will be eligible for the exclusive \$16 student flat rate.
- You can register for the Student Discount Card via the below channels:

  2. **Paper Application Form** - Please go to appropriate desk or office based on your card preference above. You will be asked to provide a valid student card with the student number during your application.
- The form must be filled out in full with your name, date of birth, email address, phone number, post code, education institute, student number and details of your vehicle for your application to be successful. Your car will then be placed upon the recognition system.
- The promoter reserves the right to photocopy your student card and verify it with your education institute.
- Upon application of a Student Parking Card, an immediate \$50 credit top-up is required. Your first day of parking is then free and from then on, you will be eligible for the exclusive \$16 student flat rate. The first day "free" parking is applicable between Monday – Friday only.
- Students Parking Cards can be used in the carpark from Monday to Sunday from 6.00am to 12.00pm only. Students must exit the car park before 12:00am (midnight) or will be charged the full daily rate.
- Student must park on Level B2 or B3 to be eligible for the offer, students who park on B1 will be required to pay the full car park fees.
- The Student Parking card is valid for one year from the date of signing up. You must apply for a new card before the expiry date to have your remaining balance transferred to a new card. Your balance will be forfeited if you are finished your course and not applying for another card, or your card has expired.

- If your Student Parking Card is lost, stolen or damaged, we can replace your card for \$20. This is the RRP cost of the card to the promoter. We can transfer your balance across to the new card. To get a replacement card, please go to the Wilson Parking Office on Level B1 of Market City car park with your student ID.
- The Student Parking Card is not transferrable and can only be used by the student it is issued to. The unauthorised use or misuse by another student or person will result in the Student Parking Card being cancelled with the remaining balance forfeited. You may occasionally be asked to show your student ID that matches the name on the card.
- Students must have their student card on them at all times and may be asked at any time to supply it by the car park attendant or may be charged the full daily rate.
- This Student Parking rate of \$16 is available with a single entry only. The rate is subject to change without notice.
- Parking spaces in the Market City car park are limited and this promotion does not guarantee that everyone will find a space.
- Market City has the right to cancel the Student Discount programme in whole (or in part) at any time without notice. The student parking promotion is a set rate and cannot be used in conjunction with any other promotion or offer.
- Student Cards also entitle the holder to discounts in participating stores. All participating stores are listed on the Students Special Offers page of the Market City website.
  - The card must be presented prior to the commencement of the sale transaction. Retailers have the right to deny a discount if you do not present your card before payment.
  - When looking at discounts online you can choose to either print the discount voucher or email it to yourself. The discount voucher must be presented with your Student Discount Card.
- This card is not a credit card.
- Market City does not share member's information with any other entity.
- All cards have a 12-month validity from the time of collection. The expiry date will be written on the back of your card.
- The claimant will also be added to the Electronic Customer Database for marketing purposes and may occasionally receive promotional emails from Market City. They may opt out by unsubscribing from those emails.
- By using the service, you will be deemed to have accepted these Terms. If you do not accept any of these Terms, you must immediately stop using the Service.
- We may change these Terms at any time. As you will be bound by any amendment to these Terms, you should review these Terms from time to time. By continuing to use the Service after any amendment to these Terms, you will be deemed to have accepted the amended Terms.

### **HOW TO USE THE STUDENT PARKING CARD:**

Have your Student Parking Card ready before entering the car park. Hold your Student Parking Card FLAT for a couple of seconds on the card recognition device on the ticket machine and the boom-gate will open for you.

Do not take a ticket to enter the car-park as the student parking rate is not valid against a ticket.

You must park on Level B2 or B3 and remain there until you leave the car-park. Failure to do so for any reason will incur higher parking charges which are non-refundable.

Make sure your student card has a minimum of \$16 credit before you exit. You can top-up your card at any pay machine.
