Market City Student Discount Card | Market City Student Parking Card

Use of the Market City Student Parking Card and Market City Student Discount Cards is governed by these terms and conditions at all times.

Market City Student Discount Card

Eligibility Criteria

- A valid NSW student card
- Must be a full time or part time student with a valid student number

How to Apply

- Register by completing the online form or via the paper form, available from the information desk located on level 1 in Market City, 9-13 Hay Street Haymarket, between 10am – 5pm Wednesday to Friday (excludes public holidays)
- The form must be completed in full to be successful
- Once you have registered for the Market City Student Discount Card, you can collect your card from the information desk, level 1 in Market City, between 10am – 5pm Wednesday to Friday (excludes public holidays).
- Upon collection, you are required to provide a valid student card with the student number used during your application

Student Discount Card Offer

- The card holder is entitled to discounts and offers at participating stores. Participating stores are listed on the students – Special Offers page on the Market City website
- Visit our website www.marketcity.com.au for a list of current offers or enquire directly at the individual retailer
- Card must be presented prior to the commencement of the sale transaction. Retailers have the right to deny a discount if you do not present your card prior to payment
- Cards have a 12-month validity from the time of collection. Date will be written on the back of your card
- When looking at the discounts online, we suggest you either print or email the voucher to yourself. The voucher must be presented with your Market City Student Discount card
- Offers available to the card holder only. You may occasionally be asked to show your student ID that matches the name on the card
- Market City has the right to change or cancel any student discounts at any time without notice. Market City has the right to cancel the Student Discount program in whole (or in part) at any time without notice
- Market City does not share member's information with any other entity
- You may receive an eNewsletter informing you of upcoming events and promotions at Market City. You may opt out by unsubscribing to those emails

Market City Student Parking Card & Student Discount Card

Eligibility Criteria

- Available to students of UTS and Ultimo TAFE only
- Must be a full time or part time student with a valid student card and student number

How to Apply

- Go to the car park office, level B1 in the Market City car park, 9-13 Hay Street Haymarket, between 10am – 5pm Monday to Friday (excludes public holidays) to complete an application.
- At the time of application, you are required to provide a valid student card with the student number for UTS or Ultimo Tafe
- The form must be completed in full to be successful
- You are required to do an immediate \$50 credit top-up on this card
- A one-off \$20 card fee also applies

Student Parking Card Offer

- \$16 per use
- Your first day parking is free (Monday – Friday only)
- Valid Weekdays only (Monday to Friday) between 6am to 12 midnight. Students must exit the car park by 12 midnight, if exiting after 12 midnight the full daily rate applies
- Must park on level B2 or B3 to be eligible for the offer. Students who park on B1 will be required to pay the full car park fees
- Cards have a 12-month validity from the date of signing-up. Date will be written on the back of your card
- The Market City Student Parking card is not transferrable and can only be used by the student it is issued to. The unauthorized use by another person may result in the cancellation of the Market City student Parking card with the remaining balance forfeited.
- The student parking card promotion is conducted by Market City in conjunction with Wilson Parking, 2 Quay Street, Haymarket, Sydney, 2000
- Application form must be completed in full with your name, date of birth, email address, phone number, postcode, education institute, student number and details of your vehicle for your application to be assessed. Your car will then be placed upon a license plate recognition system (LPR).
- Students must have their Market City Student Parking card and Student card on them at all times when using the card park. They may be asked to supply this by the parking attendant at any time, or may be charged the full daily rate.
- The Market City Student Parking card offers \$16 All Day pre-paid parking (6am to 12 midnight) with a single entry. Multiple entries will result in a \$16 charge per entry
- Parking spaces in Market City car park are limited and this promotion does not guarantee that everyone will find a space
- The Market City Student Parking rate is subject to change without notice and cannot be used in conjunction with any other offer
- Market City does not share member's information with any other entity

- You must apply for a new card prior to the expiry date to have your remaining balance transferred to a new card. Your balance will be forfeited if you are finished your course and not applying for another card, or your card has expired.
- By using the Service you will be deemed to have accepted these Terms. If you do not accept any of these Terms, you must immediately stop using the Service.
- Market City and Wilson Parking may change the Terms at any time. As you will be bound by the amendment to these Terms, you should review these Terms from time to time. By continuing to use the Service after any amendments to these Terms, you will be deemed to have accepted the amended Terms.
- The above Student Discount Card Terms also apply to the Student Parking & Discount card.
